

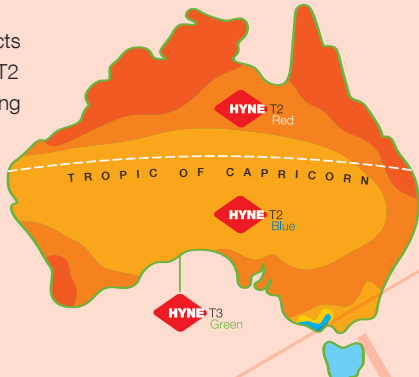

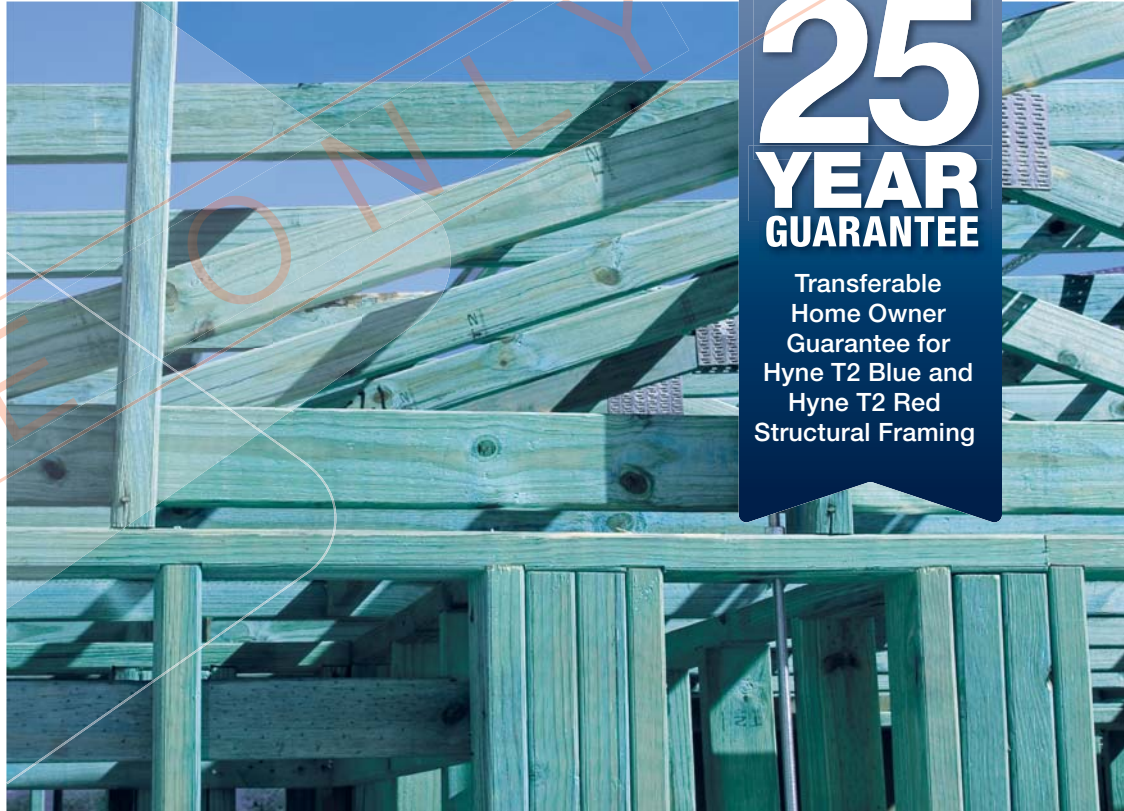

Thank you for purchasing Hyne T2 Termite Resistant Framing

Hyne and Son Pty Ltd provides this guarantee free to the home owner or purchaser of Hyne T2 Blue or Hyne T2 Red that has been preservative treated against termite attack, providing that the material has been correctly installed and maintained as outlined below.

The guarantee period is 25 years from the date of invoice. If proof of purchase is unavailable then the guarantee period will apply from the date stamp on the affected material.

Hyne T2 Blue and Hyne T2 Red are treated in accordance with

- Specifications set out in AS 1604
- The Timber Marketing Act (NSW) 1977
- The Timber Utilisation and Marketing Act (QLD) 1987

Hyne's obligation under this guarantee is to repair or replace Hyne T2 Blue or Hyne T2 Red as is damaged by termite activity to the extent that it has become structurally unfit for the purpose it was first used, providing it is within the prescribed guarantee period.

This guarantee does not cover any incidental or consequential loss or damages claimed due to termite infestation including costs associated with pest inspection, termite eradication, temporary or alternative accommodation or loss of profits or use of premises.

Hyne T2 Blue and T2 Red are intended for use as an internal construction material that are not exposed to weather or moisture but may be subject to termite attack. The guarantee only covers the material treated against termite attack and specifically excludes the following:

- Timber that does not bear the approved Hyne T2 Blue or T2 Red registered brand markings.
- Damage to Hyne T2 Blue or T2 Red termite resistant timber caused by rot, fungal decay, warping, twisting, swelling or any other cause apart from termite attack.
- Damage to Hyne T2 Blue termite resistant timber caused by termites when used above the Tropic of Capricorn.
- Damage to other timbers, materials or fixtures contained in the house or structure.
- Any Hyne T2 Blue or Hyne T2 Red timber that has been re-dressed, rip sawn or had its dimensions significantly altered. Docking to length and notching is permitted.
- Any T2 Blue or T2 Red timber that has not been correctly installed or maintained as set out on the following page.

REQUIRED MAINTENANCE PROCEDURES

- Regularly inspect for termite mud tracks entering your home and have a qualified pest or building inspector carry out regular property inspections every one or two years.
- Do not build garden beds or raise lawns against the side of buildings as this may allow termites access to your structure.
- Do not join any structures to the side of buildings unless the necessary measures have been undertaken to prevent termite entry.

TO MAKE A CLAIM UNDER THIS GUARANTEE, THE OWNER MUST:

- Notify Hyne immediately there is visible evidence of termite infestation.
- Provide Hyne with written notice of the Owners intention to claim under this guarantee and evidence of proof of purchase or date of supply or manufacture as well as the site address and contact details of the property owner or agent working on their behalf.
- Provide Hyne or their nominated representative, access to the property to inspect the alleged damage to the Hyne T2 Blue or Hyne T2 Red prior to removal from service.

Failure to comply with these requirements may void this guarantee.
